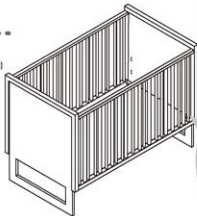

Step 7

- Secure the Mattress Board K by inserting 1 Screw A (50mm/2.0") through each of the four corner holes and into the brackets.
- Tighten all four screws with Allen wrench.

The Product and Manufacturing Process

Nurseryworks products are made from sustainable wood wherever possible and also from high-quality wood veneers. The primary material used in our products is Pouapepe wood which is harvested from plantations and renewed every 10-12 years. Zero-grade VOC, containing well below the regulated limit of formaldehyde, is used sparingly in components of our products to achieve our signature carvings and single board set outs. All paints, finishes and glues are low-VOC. Our products are tested on a frequent basis to ensure that all coatings and finishes comply with U.S. and Canadian heavy metal requirements.

Each Nurseryworks product is a unique piece crafted largely by hand. We use a specialized machinery process to create our hallmark carvings and each piece is constructed and lacquered by hand. Our lacquering process involves over a dozen steps to sand and polish the furniture to achieve our glossy finish. With proper care and assembly, your Nurseryworks products will be a part of your family for years to come.

Please note that due to the handcrafted nature of

our products and our use of solid woods, each piece is unique and may contain irregular qualities, such as natural markings, minuscule burs, or slight discolorations. These natural characteristics are inherent in wood, are not considered manufacturing defects and do not need replacements.

Maintenance and Cleaning:

To preserve the hand-crafted quality of Nurseryworks furniture, we recommend using a cotton cloth and a non-toxic cleaner. Periodic polishing or oiling on wood stains will help to maintain the rich wood tones. For our upholstered products, we recommend using water to clean suede products and light foam cleaner for all other fabrics.

If your child is teething, some furniture's finish may be affected. Be assured that our low-VOC lacquers, finishes and glues comply with applicable regulations and standards. We suggest using protective covers on the top rails. Touch up kits and replacement parts are available for purchase upon request by contacting Nurseryworks at:

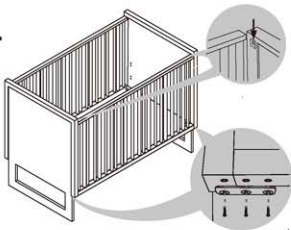
- Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- Do not use this crib if the enclosed or attached instructions cannot be strictly adhered to.
- Infants can suffocate on soft bedding.
- Never add a pillow, comforter or padding.
- Read all instructions before assembling crib.
- Keep instructions for future use.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- Strangulation Hazard: Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's

- neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- Do not place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this crib.
- To help prevent strangulation, tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- DO NOT place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- Fall Hazard: When child is able to pull to a standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- FOR DROP SIDE CRIB MODELS

- ONLY: After raising the side, make sure latches are secure.
- FOR DROP SIDE CRIB MODELS ONLY: DO NOT leave child in crib with side lowered. Be sure side is in raised and locked position whenever child is in crib.
- When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in. (90cm), the crib shall no longer be used.
- To ensure a safer environment for your child, check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use before placing child in the crib. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact Nurseryworks, Inc. for replacement parts and instructional literature if

Step 6

- Attach the 2nd Slat Panel J to both End Panels I by aligning both female and male Rail Clips (as done in Step 3).
- Attach remaining E Plates in two places along the bottom of Slat Panel I using 3 B Screws (15mm/0.6"), (as done in Step 3).
- Tighten all screws with Allen wrench before proceeding to the next step.

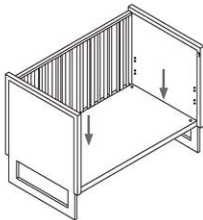

- Install the *Mattress Board* by matching up the four corner holes in the board with the four D Brackets installed in Step 2

Do NOT screw down yet.



needed. DO NOT substitute parts.

- Tighten all screws securely at each step of the instructions. Check frequently to be certain they remain tight and secure.
- DO NOT use a water mattress with this crib.
- If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- This product contains small parts. Keep small parts out of children's reach during assembly.
- Properly discard all packaging materials after assembly is complete.

CAUTION:

Any mattress used in this crib must be at least 27 1/4 inches (69cm) by 51 5/8 inches (131cm) with a thickness not exceeding 6 inches (15cm). The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15cm (6") thick and should be of such length and width that the gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is not more than 3cm (1.2") when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.

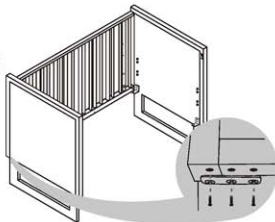

Step 4

- Fasten the other end of Slot Panel J to the 2nd End Panel I by repeating the steps in Step 3.
- Tighten all screws with Allen wrench before proceeding to the next step.

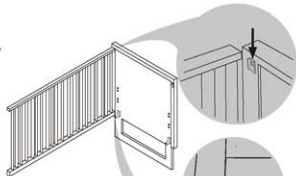


Step 3

• Attach Slot Panel J to End Panel I by aligning the pre-installed Female Rail Clip G with the Male Rail Clip F installed in Step 1. Push down firmly to set in place.

• Screw Plate E into bottom of Slot Panel J using 3 B (15mm/0.6") Screws.

• Tighten all screws with Allen wrench before proceeding to the next step.

★ Be sure you follow the instructions in the order that they appear.

To avoid possible scratching, assemble furniture on a soft surface, for instance on a carpet or blanket.

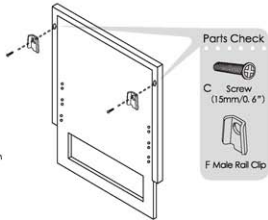
Be aware that you can use both ends of the Allen wrench. For instance, use it lengthwise to get into tighter corners.

Be careful not to over tighten screws.

Loom Crib Assembly Instructions

Step 1

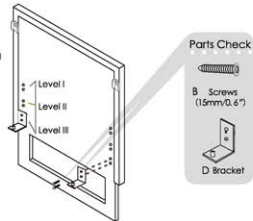
- Use 1 C Screw (15mm/0.6") to fasten Male Rail Clip F to the top hole of the End Panel I with a Phillips screwdriver (not included).
- 2 clips per panel - total of 4 clips
- Tighten all screws with Allen wrench before proceeding to the next step.



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Step 2

- Determine at what level you would like to place your mattress board.
 - I Highest
 - II Middle
 - III Lowest
- Insert 28 screws (15mm/0.6") through Bracket D and into your chosen corresponding holes.
- 4 Brackets total. 2 per End Panel.
- Tighten all screws with Allen wrench before proceeding to the next step.



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
